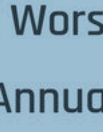
Please continue to be praying for :

Kenya Outreach Trip

*Awendo, Lake Victoria
 15 - 19 May 2024*

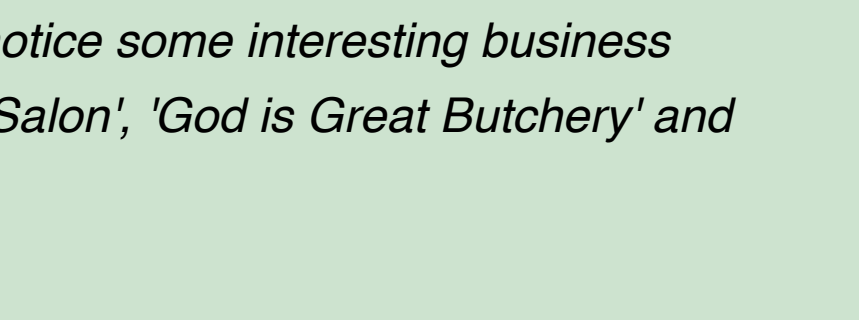
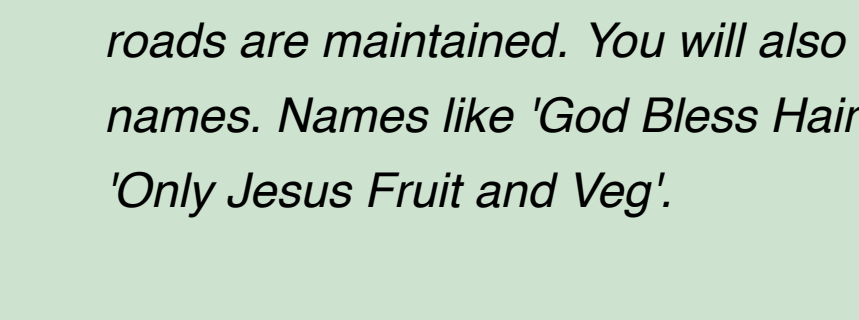
A team from the FMI family, consisting of John Crumpton, Chris Liebenberg, James Kato and Jaco Botma visited the network of leaders led by Joseph Ngega and his team from Awendo, close to Lake Victoria. This is the fourth visit to this network of churches that are part of the FMI family.

Pastors and leaders from Nairobi, Kisumu, Tanzania and the Islands of Lake Victoria also joined us for a 3-day conference on Church Planting & Discipleship. Every day, from 09:00 to 18:00, was packed with hungry leaders eager to learn and work through training material from Dr Hendrik Vorster that have been translated to Swahili.

What a wonderful experience it was to observe the grace to evangelise the lost and bring them into a local church where they are discipled. There are 123 churches that form part of this network and are overseen by Joseph and his team. The fact that the training material is translated in Swahili is a great resource!

On the way back to the airport, an inquisitive young man stopped by and engaged in a conversation with Chris. This young man surrendered his life to the Lord during this conversation. The harvest is ripe in Kenya and it feels so easy to share the Gospel and lead people to Jesus.

This is Jaco Botma’s impression of the mission trip:

This was my first time in Kenya. I could not help to notice when you drive from Kisumu to Awendo, how clean the streets are and how well the roads are maintained. You will also notice some interesting business names. Names like 'God Bless Hair Salon', 'God is Great Butchery' and 'Only Jesus Fruit and Veg'.

Kenya has not been as secularised as South Africa and people take their religion seriously. In SA there has been a campaign to remove God from nearly every public space. This is the definition of a God-less society. And the fruits are evident.

Kenya is a more God-focused society and the fruits are also evident there. One example is that they have stood firm, along with other African countries, against the West’s pressure to be more inclusive of people with different sexual orientations.

On a Kingdom level, I feel that the church leaders we have met are humble, worthy men who can say along with Paul, “I have learned to be content”. They continue with what God has called them to, despite the availability or lack of resources.

They have a passion for the gospel despite facing many challenges and are avid church planters.

We enjoyed amazing hospitality from them and had great fellowship. We loved seeing how the team related with one another and realised again that good relationships are fundamental in the growing and building of the Kingdom.

May God continue to bless His work in Kenya and may He continue to give us opportunities to partner with Him in what He is doing in Africa.
